Reminisce about the CH Horsham and Hertford era through scrapbooks, photographs, copies of the Blue, house lists and original film footage of St. Matthew's Day marching pupils dating back to 1928. Enjoy our exhibition 'Brangwyn's Cartoons at Christ's Hospital', about the story of the murals in Chapel and the designer craftsman who created them, along with seven conserved sketches.
